

HELP YOUR COMMUNITY ENSURE AN ACCURATE CENSUS IN 2020

Who: By law, every 10 years the Census counts every person living in the United States.

What: Every person is asked to fill out a form with basic questions about where you live and who you are; all data collected will only be used for purposes of the Census, no other government agency can see your answers.

Where: You can respond to the Census by mail, over the phone, and for the first time in 2020, via the internet.

When: By April 1, 2020, everyone will be invited to respond to the Census.

Why: Your responses are used to help determine where to build new schools, hospitals, and businesses; how federal funding is distributed; and how congressional districts are apportioned.
